Project applicants that attempted to participate in CoC planning process for FY 2018 funds in the geographic area in which they operate, that believe they were denied the right to participate in a reasonable manner may appeal the CoC's decision not to include their project application in the CoC Priority Listing for FY 2018 funds. (Must be submitted by September 18th)

FY2018 Funds Available (estimate)

- Total Annual Renewal Demand: \$15,725,259
- PSH/RRH/or Joint TH and RRH Bonus (up to 6% of FPRN)= \$1,052,242
- DV Bonus (up to 10% of PPRN) = \$1,753,736
- CoC Planning (MDHA) not competitive (3% of total FPRN) \$526,121

Scoring Structure

Project Applicants get scored locally and placed into Tier 1 or Tier 2 as recommendation to HUD.

Tier 2 then competes nationally using a 100 point scale consisting of

- a. 50 points based on CoC wide score nationally
- b. 40 points based on where in Tier 2 the project was ranked and
- c. 10 points for evidence of housing first principles in the project application.

Available Funds in FY18 Tier System

Tier 1 Subject to high CoC 94% of ARD = \$14,781,743 application score. Tier 2 6% of Renewal \$943,516 Subject to high CoC application score 6% Bonus FPRN \$1,052,242 AND project score 10% Bonus DV PPRN \$1,753,363 Based on application ranking plus specific 100 point scale **TOTAL FY18 = \$16,777,501 + DV Bonus**

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NEW- Projects from Bonus & Reallocation

- Must be one of the following
 - Permanent housing-permanent supportive housing (PH-PSH) projects that meet the requirements of Dedicated PLUS or where 100 percent of the beds are dedicated to individuals and families experiencing chronic homelessness
 - New permanent housing-rapid rehousing (PH-RRH) projects that will serve homeless individuals and families, including unaccompanied youth
 - Joint TH and PH-RRH component to better serve homeless individuals and families, including individuals or families fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking

NEW - Projects from DV Bonus

- New projects that want to be considered for the DV Bonus, may be:
 - Permanent Housing-Rapid re-housing projects dedicated to serving survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking
 - Joint TH and PH-RRH component projects dedicated to serving survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking
 - Supportive service only-coordinated entry project to implement policies, procedures, and practices that equip the CoC's coordinated entry to better meet the needs of survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking

New Projects from DV Bonus

- Must be 1 year grant term
- Only one submission per project type (PH, RRH-TH, SSO-CES) per CoC
- HUD will conditionally select DV Bonus projects based on the criteria established in the NOFA
 - Any project conditionally selected by HUD as part of the DV Bonus will be removed from the CoC's New Project ranking list and all projects underneath of it will slide up in rank
 - Any project that indicated it would like to be considered as part of the DV Bonus but was not selected as part of the DV Bonus, will retain the ranking provided by the CoC and be considered as a normal ranked project*

New Projects from DV Bonus Score

- Combination of CoC Application score and responses to the domestic violence bonus specific questions in the Collaborative Application using the following 100-point scale:
- For Rapid Re-housing and Joint TH and PH-RRH component projects:
 - CoC Score. Up to 50 points in direct proportion to the score received on the CoC Application.
 - Need for the Project. Up to 25 points based on the extent the CoC is able to quantify the need for the project
 - Quality of the Project Applicant. Up to 25 points based on the previous performance of the applicant related to DV.
- For SSO Projects for Coordinated Entry:
 - CoC Score. Up to 50 points in direct proportion to the score received on the CoC Application.
 - Need for the Project. Up to 50 points based on the extent to which the CoC is able to demonstrate the need for a coordinated entry system that better meets the needs of clients

Consolidated Projects

- Prior to considering a Project Consolidation, applicant should consult with local HUD field office to ensure eligibility
- Applicants that intend to use the consolidation process to combine two to four eligible renewal projects may do so through the renewal project application
- Projects must be held by the same recipient
- Projects must be of the same project component type

How to Consolidate Projects

- Submit Renewal applications for each grant
 - Select "yes" on "Renewal Grant Consolidation Screen" in eSNAPS
- Select a surviving grant (grant with the earliest start date)
- Submit up to 3 terminating grants
- Submit a "fully consolidated" renewal application with information from all combining grants included.

Dedicated PLUS:

- DedicatedPLUS: A PSH project where 100% of the beds are dedicated to serve individuals with disabilities and families in which one adult OR child has a disability, including unaccompanied homeless youth, that at intake are:
 - Experiencing chronic homelessness
 - In TH that will be eliminated and meets the definition of chronically homeless upon entry into TH
 - Literally homeless, previously chronically homeless, but exited a permanent housing project within last year.
 - In TH funded by joint TH and RRH who were experiencing CH prior to entry
 - Literally homeless at least 12 months in the last three years but not on four separate occasions
 - In VA funded program and meets on of the above criteria at initial intake to VA program

Joint TH-RRH

- Joint TH-RRH: Project that includes two existing program components—transitional housing and permanent housing-rapid rehousing—in a single project to serve individuals and families experiencing homelessness.
 - Provides both components as an option for participants to choose from
 - Must be Housing First in BOTH component types and only provide 24 months of assistance TOTAL for each participant.
